

## *A Biblical Detection Problem*

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Only one 5-letter word is found in Verse -----,  
Chapter -----, Book of -----, in the Bible.  
What is it?

The number of dashes equals the number of letters of the words.

<i>Proposition</i>	<i>Possibilities</i>	
A Book of 10 letters	Colossians, <i>Revelation</i>	Chronicles not used because of '1' and '2'
A Chapter of 6 letters	Eleven, Twelve, <i>Twenty</i>	This eliminates Col. as it has only 4 Chapters. (Neither Book has thirty Chapters.) The three Chapters above all have at least 15 Verses, so any of the three are eligible.
A Verse of 7 letters	<i>Fifteen</i> , Sixteen	Chaps 11 and 12 in Revelations have <i>more</i> than one 5-letter word in both Verses 15 and 16. In Chap. 20, however, Verse 15 contains only one 5-letter word which, oddly enough, is, FOUND!
Only one 5-letter word		

Note that this answer holds good in both the King James version and the Revised Standard Version.
