A core course proposal should not be held longer than one month in the area committee. If the proposal is held within the committee for a month, then the director has the authority to make a unilateral decision OR forward it to the CCC so they can make the decision. If the area decision is delayed because of a need for faculty response to the area committee's suggestions, then the area committee has one month after the revised proposal is submitted to make a decision.
