Scott, Professor and Head, Department of Religion and Culture, United Theological College, Bangalore; and Dr. Mrs. Vijayalakshmy, Research Fellow, Indian Institute of Advanced Studies, Simla.

Duties of the Editorial Board include the provision of advice on the form and content of each issue of the Bulletin to the editors and the offering of suggestions as to themes to be addressed, books to be reviewed and news to be included in future issues.

Raimundo Panikkar Edits New Monograph Series

The Indian Theological Association has launched the "Indic Theological Monographs" with Raimundo Panikkar as the General Editor. The new series will focus on contemporary problems in South Asia from the perspective of theological disciplines. In particular, theological reflections on the spreading technocratic civilization, ecological issues, the nuclear threat and the need for interaction among the various religious traditions are welcome.
