## CHANGING FASHIONS IN NAMES FOR GIRLS

Females can often be dated by their names: how many teenage Florences exist, or elderly Brittanys? My middle daughter has often taken me to task for saddling her with the name Lois, usually associated with women a quarter-century older (the name Lois achieved its greatest popularity in 1929-30, and had vanished from the thousand commonest female names by 1984). Perhaps I should have heeded Alexander Pope's 1711 advice, substituting *names* for *words*:

In words as fashions, the same rule will hold. Alike fantastic if too new or old; Be not the first by whom the new are tried, Nor yet the last to lay the old aside.

In the last decade, a massive database, Popular Baby Names, has been made available by the Social Security Administration, depicting changing fashions in names for girls; it can be found at www.ssa.gov/OACT/babynames/. This tabulates the relative ranks of the thousand commonest female names from 1880 through 2009, consisting of all Social Security cards issued to residents of the 50 states, starting with nearly 100 thousand female names born in 1880, and rising to more than a million by 1920 and two million by 1960. (It contains corresponding statistics for male names as well.)

Let us begin by tabulating each name which achieved the first rank for one or more years. The listing of these years is followed by the number of (earlier) years the name took to rise from the tenth to the first rank, the number of years from its first through its last appearance as number one, and the number of (later) years it took to decline from the first to the eleventh rank. These three numbers collectively measure the staying power of a name. The final number gives the rank in 2009 (or the last year the rank was less than one thousand).

The most striking name is Mary, who reigned at the top of the list for 82 years; this reflects at least in part the Catholic predilection for the mother of Jesus. Emma has enjoyed a renaissance, having been ranked third 1880-86, but ranking as low as 460 in 1976.

Is it possible that the name Shirley received a boost from the child film star of the 1930s, Shirley Temple, and that the name Deborah was similarly influenced by the 1950s star Deborah Kerr? Could Dorothy have been named after the heroine in Frank Baum's book *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz* and its many successors? The name Anna has held up surprisingly well, never dropping below the rank of 106 (in 1971).

Elizabeth has had remarkable staying power, never dropping below rank 26 (in 1948). Note how briefly Brittany and Alexis enjoyed the limelight—only nine and eight years, respectively.
