

# STATENAMES REVISITED

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Over the years, the names of the 50 states of the USA have been pored over in the pages of Word Ways. Transposals of the statenames have been logged for most of them. Some examples: INDIANA anidian, MINNESOTA nominates, NEW YORK ywroken, TEXAS taxes, WASHINGTON nowanights.

There are related areas which haven't received the same amount of attention, though. These can be summarised in the following two questions. For each of the statenames,

- (1) what is the longest word that can be made up from a subset of the letters of the statename?
- (2) what is the shortest word using all the letters of the statename, and at least one additional letter?

Take CALIFORNIA, for example. In answer to (1), there are several words of seven letters, including AIRFOIL and OCARINA, but the longest are the eight-letter specimens CONARIAL and IRONICAL. In answer to (2), CRANIOFACIAL seems to be the shortest word using all the letters of CALIFORNIA, with A and C as the additional letters.

My best suggestions for the 50 statenames are given in the table below. Single-letter transdeletions and transadditions have been marked with an asterisk. In several cases there are no words using all the letters of a particular statename, plus other letters. These have been indicated by hyphens.

Can readers improve on my words? Can the subject of statename wordplay be broadened further? How?

Editor's Note: The most recalcitrant statename appears to be Mississippi, with no possible transaddition and a five-step transdeletion required. North Dakota, South Dakota, Pennsylvania and Massachusetts are nearly as bad, all requiring four-step transdeletions. However, note that Alabama and Colorado, both requiring three-step transdeletions, achieve transadditions using only two and three extra letters, respectively! At the other extreme, Rhode Island has a minimal one-step transdeletion but no possible transaddition; Washington and Wyoming, also with one-step transdeletions, need five extra letters to construct their transadditions, and New York needs three.
