

EGGSHELLS – 1

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An *eggshell* is what remains when two different pairs of identical consonants are removed from a word. Consequently, E S H E is an eggshell which results from the excision of two “G”s and two “L”s from the word EGG SHELL.

Twenty eggshells are displayed in the list which follows. Simply insert the missing consonant pairs into their appropriate positions to rediscover the words from which these eggshells originated. No scrambling is necessary.
