

THREE TIMES TWO IS SIX

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The thirty two-letter words displayed below need to be assembled into ten six-letter words in order to justify the arithmetically-correct title of this piece. Accordingly, MI, AS, and MA might be concatenated to form MIASMA. When the goal is eventually reached, no two-letter blocks that begin with the same letter will appear in the same word (thus disqualifying MIASMA) and no two of the answers will begin with the same letter.
