

TRANSPOSING PHRASES PART 3

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In Part 3 of *Transposing Phrases*, both 2-word phrases share a word.
 The two like words may both be (a) at the beginning of the 2 phrases or (b) at the end of the 2 phrases.

(a) BOTH 2-WORD PHRASES BEGIN WITH THE SAME WORD

Together, the two second words transpose into *a single word*.
