

WORD SEGMENTS REORDERED

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This is a different type of transposal. A word is cut through in one or more places to make 2 or more words. These words are then reordered to make a phrase of 2 (usually) or more* words.

I have only considered phrases which have no relation to the initial word.

ARMSTRONG = STRONG ARM

ASSAILANTS = ANTS ASSAIL

BARCAROLES = CAROLE'S BAR

BRIEFLESS (no pants) = LESS BRIEF (longer)

CATATONIC = A CAT TONIC*

COLLINEAR = I NEAR COLL*

FOUNDLING = LING FOUND

GANGLIONS = LION'S GANG

LITHEsome = HE LIT SOME*

MANICURE = I CURE MAN*

ORIGINALS = AL'S ORIGIN

OVERBREAK = BREAK (coffee) OVER

OWNERSHIP = SHIP OWNER

PILLAGE = AGE PILL

RENEGATED = GATED RENE

SIDEBURNS = BURNS SIDE (ouch!)

SINGALONG = A LONG SING*

STABILISE = I STAB LISE*

TARPAULIN = PAUL IN TAR*

ASCENDANTS = ANTS ASCEND

BACKCLOTH = CLOTH BACK (chair)

BARGAINED = GAINED BAR

CASTRATED = RATED CAST

CLAYMORE = MORE CLAY

FORESTALL = ALL FOREST

FREEMASONS = MASON'S FREE

HORSEFACE = FACE HORSE

MACERATED = RATED MACE

ONCOMING = COMING ON

OUTCRY = CRY OUT
