

TRIPLE WORD LADDER PHRASES

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Consider the 3-word phrase VAN LED WAY. *Change the first of the 3 letters in each word to make another phrase, JAN WED RAY.* Repeat the exercise to make a third phrase, IAN FED MAY.

VAN LED WAY

JAN WED RAY

IAN FED MAY

VAN, JAN and IAN form a word ladder; LED, WED and FED form word ladder; WAY, RAY and MAY form a word ladder. These are Triple Word Ladder Phrases.

Another example is:

RON HIT MAN

DON LIT PAN

JON BIT DAN

A similar exercise *changes the second of the 3 letters in each word* to make another phrase.

THE HOT TIP

TOE HIT TAP

TIE HAT TOP

SHE HAD ACE

SUE HID AXE

SEE HUD AGE

Here *the third of the 3 letters in each word is changed* to make another phrase.

LEN HIT BIN

LET HIM BID

LEO HID BIB

REG HAS RIB

REP HAD RIG

RED HAT RIM
